This Development network is a well established group who meet for 3 days over the course of an academic year. Whilst the days form part of an ongoing programme they are also stand-alone sessions, enabling schools to choose to send a different member of their department each time if they wish.

Following the rhythm of the academic year:

- The Autumn meeting has an emphasis on new developments, what local and national outcomes data can tell us about supporting our learners effectively
- The Spring meeting has a strong teaching and learning focus including strategies to support learners as they prepare for summer examinations.
- The Summer meeting includes a leadership focus on current impact, effectiveness of implementation and development planning for the coming year.

- learn about new developments locally and nationally
- have the opportunity to collaborate and identify best practice with colleagues from other schools.
- hear from experts from across the sector such as exam boards, CPD providers and centres of mathematical research.
