NATIONAL PROVIDER UPDATES

In June 2022, L.E.A.D. Teaching School Hub contributed to the Ofsted inspection of the ECF and NPQ Programmes on behalf of the nationally accredited lead provider, Education Development Trust. This was a monitoring visit prior to the full inspections which are due to begin in 2023.

Education Development Trust works in partnership with 37 delivery partners throughout the UK and at the time of the inspection there were 4,138 early career teachers (ECTs) on the ECF training programme and 2,367 participants on NPQ programmes.

As a local delivery partner, we feel particularly pleased that Ofsted praised the content of its ECF and NPQ curriculums as "effective" and L.E.A.D. Teaching School Hub was praised during the inspection for contextualising and adapting the content successfully to meet the needs of teachers and leaders across Lincolnshire.

The outcome of the inspection recognises that there are a number of improvements still to be made including systems and processes and the way in which the lead provider quality assures the work of the Teaching School Hubs at a local level.

As a designated Teaching School Hub, we remain consistent in our ambition to provide the highest quality of delivery and content across both the ECF and NPQ programmes, in order to impact positively upon leadership and teaching across Lincolnshire. As we head into year two of operation, we will therefore continue to monitor the quality of <u>all</u> lead providers to ensure that we select and provide the very best for Lincolnshire schools.

DFE CONSULTATION: APPROPRIATE BODY REFORMS AND INDUCTION ASSESSMENT

In the 'Opportunity for all' white paper, published in March 2022, the department committed to reforming the role of the appropriate body (AB). In the induction guidance for ABs published in 2021 the department also committed to introducing stronger quality assurance of the AB sector. In response, the department launched a consultation on AB reforms and induction assessment in the summer term.

Full details are provided in the 'Appropriate body reform and induction assessment: Consultation document'.

L.E.A.D. Teaching School Hub, alongside the Lincolnshire Hub Delivery Partners engaged with this consultation. This was with the aim of helping to improve the quality of AB services and the induction experience for all parties involved in the ECT induction process.

We thank those of you who shared the consultation links and provided feedback to improve the system in relation to the Appropriate Body services. The government is expected to publish its response to the consultation in Autumn 2022 and we will share this with you.
